## COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE (CDL) TRAINING POLICY

**WHEREAS**, effective February 7, 2022 the WisDOT has implemented new restrictions on securing a Commercial Driver's License (DCL), which limit employers the ability to train new employees on the job; and

WHEREAS, City of Manitowoc strives to hire the best candidates for open positions, and to remain competitive the City would like to reimburse new employees needing a CDL upon successful completion of the Entry-Level Driving Training (ELDT) Program and passing the CDL exam within 6 months of hire; and

**WHEREAS,** the Personnel Committee recommended approval of a Commercial Driver's License Training Policy, at a meeting held on March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc to approve the attached Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Training Policy.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** to direct Human Resources to implement this new Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Training Policy, effective upon passage of this Resolution.
