Since former City Attorney Kathleen McDaniel's last update on April 28th, and her departure on May 18th, the City Attorney's Office continues to monitor the following projects:

Environmental Remediation

- Lemberger Landfill: Work continues as planned. Dan Koski has taken an interim lead.
- Gravel Pit: Godfrey Kahn continues as legal counsel. Watermain project continues.
- WPS Superfund Site: No update.

Open Records Requests

- EPA re the City's Brownfield Program (Adam Tegen is handling)
- Wisconsin Public Defender's Office Subpoena for PD's records re a 2018 homicide assistance with the City of Two Rivers (IT is working on and if necessary, records will be forwarded to Attorney Wachewicz for final review.)
- Routine open record requests are being handled by City Clerk Mackenzie Reed-Kadow.

Litigation, Prosecution, and Neighborhood Improvement

- MAVCB/Hearty Olive suit: Set for court date in June, Smitha Chintamaneni of vonBriesen handling for City
