Amber,

Here are the ordinance changes for the new stop sign at North 11<sup>th</sup> and Huron St. and the new Yield Sign on N. 8<sup>th</sup> St. at Cleveland Ave.

Can you please put an item on the March Public Safety Committee Agenda for these changes?

1. Section 10.190. Create an ordinance for the new Yield Sign on North 8<sup>th</sup> St. and Cleveland Ave. to read as follows: **“A Yield sign shall be installed on the southeast corner of the intersection of North 8<sup>th</sup> St. and Cleveland Ave. and all vehicles turning right onto Cleveland Avenue from North 8<sup>th</sup> Street shall yield the right-of-way to vehicles traveling east on Cleveland Avenue”.**
2. Section 10.230 (17) shall be created to read as follows: **“There shall be a four-way stop at the intersection of North 11<sup>th</sup> and Huron Street”.**
