RE: County's Proposed Reconstruction of CTH "CL" (Viebahn St.) from S. 10th to S. 26th St.

Members of the Public Infrastructure Committee:

The Manitowoc County Highway Department has informed us that they plan to reconstruct CTH "CL" (Viebahn Street) from South 10th to South 26th St. It is anticipated that the project will be completed in 2024 or 2025 depending upon funding.

In accordance with the existing policies, the City will be responsible for some of the costs of the reconstruction work.

The City will be responsible for the cost of any pavement wider than 30 feet.

In the case of Viebahn Street, which is a 46 foot wide street, I believe that means the City will be responsible for the cost of 16-feet of pavement and also the cost of the concrete curb and gutter.

In addition, any utility repairs or adjustments, etc. (sanitary and storm sewer) will be the City's responsibility.

I believe that we will have to reline the existing concrete sanitary sewer pipes along Viebahn St., so there will be significant utility costs on this street. We will be televising the storm sewer from S. 18th St. to S. 26th St. in 2023 to get more up to date information (existing is from 2006). The storm sewers from S. 10th to S. 18th Street were televised in 2017 so we will be reviewing that information as well.

This item was on the agenda for informational purposes and to let the elected officials know about upcoming costs that will be the City's responsibility, so that we can incorporate these costs into the capital budget for the proposed year of the improvements.
