Re: Unfunded budget request

In the 2021 Fiscal Budget the MFRD was approved to purchase gear for new members within the fire rescue department. The gear was not received until first quarter of fiscal year 2022. This resulted in the money being utilized from FY 2022 budget to pay expense rather than the FY 2021 budget.

The purpose of the unfunded request is to ensure 10 sets of personal protect gear consisting of structural firefighting gear be purchased for new members being hired in 2022 and replacement of 3 sets of expired gear.

The life expectancy of the structural gear is 10 years per NFPA guidelines for structural firefighting gear.
