

## **Email From Mayor Nickels**

Good Afternoon Finance Committee –

Last evening you inquired about the cost to run water main to the Town of Newton to deal with our gravel pit issue and contaminated wells.

First the revenues:

\$3.4 million in ARPA funding. If the county matches that 100%, we would have a total of \$6.8 million in federal funds available.

We also have a settlement from Newell Rubbermaid still sitting in an account for \$1.7 million.

So in total we would have \$8.5 million for this project.

The costs are split into 3 phases:

Phase 1 is estimated at roughly \$3.4 million and the other 2 phases coming in at a total of about \$5.5-\$6.5 million for a total of around \$9 to \$10 million for the entire project.

To date we have spent well over \$6 million over the last decade on this issue (Karen Dorrow can provide you a better number). Those are 100% City of Manitowoc taxpayer dollars.
