**RECLASSIFY – COMMUNITY SERVICE WORKER TO
COMMUNITY SERVICE WORKER SUPERVISOR/FLEET MAINTENANCE**

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has submitted a request to revise and reclassify an eliminated Community Service Worker position to a Community Service Worker Supervisor/Fleet Maintenance position, in support of law enforcement activities for in-house squad, vehicle and equipment maintenance demands; and

WHEREAS, on December 5th, 2022, the Personnel Committee unanimously approved to rename and reclassify the Community Service Worker to a Community Service Worker Supervisor/Fleet Maintenance position, along with the revised job description of Community Service Worker Supervisor/Fleet Maintenance position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc to approve renaming and reclassifying the Community Service Worker position, currently in this role, to a Community Service Worker Supervisor/Fleet Maintenance position, along with the attached revised job description, as an exempt, salaried position at Grade G, effective January 1, 2023, according to the Compensation Plan and Employee Policy Manual, and the Mayor’s approved 2023 Executive Budget.
