

## ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to adjust rates for sewer service charges effective March 1, 2023.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** The sewer service charges established in Manitowoc Municipal Code § 25.050(8) are hereby set as follows:
