- 1) I feel this is the best location due the proximity to streets, lots, and topo. It has the most access right now, and with really no further development planned for this park at this point, I think the proposed parking lot can be moved later if it ever happens. This location would leave room for restrooms and a road into the park off of either road abutting this corner.
- 2) This would be my second choice. It is the next closest area to the entrance of the park as well as the lots, that is relatively flat. This would allow for future construction of the proposed parking lot. The bad part would be that right now it will be a long walk from the entrance unless users trespass on private undeveloped lots.
- 3) This is similar to #2, only a little further back in the park.


