**RE:** Maritime Metro Transit Route 6B for Waldo Blvd 2020 Reconstruction

The 2020 Waldo reconstruction project has directly impacted the 6A route of Maritime Metro Transit as the path is on Waldo Blvd. For the duration of the project, 6B will be in operation to service the citizens on the NW side of Manitowoc. The segment of 6B that still must be negotiated is the path along 18<sup>th</sup> St., once it becomes one-way NB.

MMT is proposing to cross Waldo Blvd at  $15^{th}$  St. when the project allows for the following reasons:

- This is the best option to service the city and routes with the least disruption & least amount of changes to the route
  - The elementary school stop will remain on route, without disruption to the service or the children who use MMT during the school year and during Summer School
- The ADRC will be serviced with a temporary stop at 15<sup>th</sup> & New York
- The Aquatic Center will be serviced with a temporary stop at 15<sup>th</sup> & Wisconsin

I recommend the City support the following requests:

1. Temporary removal of parking from the west side of N. 15<sup>th</sup> St. from Waldo Blvd. to New York Ave.
