Last week, Amber Daugs from Grow It Forward, Inc. with the S 14th St. Community Garden called wondering about the possibility of placing raised beds in the terrace area. They are planning to do a Garden Blitz event on 5/21/16 where they will build raised beds for people. Her aunt is interested in having a raised bed in the terrace area. Amber is aware that the plants would have to be short as to not block the vision and about keeping the vision triangle clear. The beds that they place in yards are typically 4'x8'x10" high. I talked to Sonja, & she indicated these would not be allowed in the terrace area, but Amber has said that other cities have things written into their municipal code to allow these terrace beds, and she is wondering how to pursue this for the City of Manitowoc.
