For the west leg or eastbound approach on Dewey ST. Is the request to have a separate left turn only lane along the centerline and then a thru and right turn lane in the lane adjacent to the curb??

Based on a traffic count from 2009, there were 1,511 left turns from eastbound Dewey St. onto northbound S. 10th St. There were 402 that went straight and 362 that turned right.

I do not really understand the request or how this would make the intersection any better or safer. It does not seem like there is really an issue here. Am I missing something??

Or is it that vehicles straddle or hog the center of the eastbound lane, which does not allow the car behind them to pick either lane.

Perhaps, just a white 8" channelizing line between the lanes would be sufficient and do not designate the traffic movements. Do not paint any arrows. Just have the line, so that there are two distinct lanes. However, this would likely require removal of parking on the south side of Dewey St. from S. 10th St. to the first driveway west of 10th St.

We are planning to repaint Dewey St. in the summer of 2024, so if we do make any changes it will be easy enough to add this work to the contract.
