

Dear Aldermen,

I am writing to ask permission to hold the 14th Annual MPPA Police Chase run/walk fundraiser on Saturday 10-08-16 at Silver Creek Park. This year's profits are again going to be donated to the Manitowoc Police Department K-9 Program. Several officers from the Manitowoc Police Department will be coordinating this event to raise money to help sustain the K-9 Program.

No dog, cat or other creature shall be permitted on or in any school ground, public playground, cemetery or public park in the City of Manitowoc, unless said dog, cat or other creature is assisting a disabled individual, participating in an event sponsored or approved by the Recreation Department or as allowed under subsection (5)(b) of this section.

Since this event is directly benefiting the City of Manitowoc K9 Fund, we are also requesting a waiver of the special events license fee.


Participants will start to gather at 8 am and should be out of the park by 11:30am. As required by the city, we will have a valid special event insurance policy.
