Prior to 12/17 the sewer lines at the Lakeshore CAP offices located at 702 State Street were clogged and non-functioning. We contact our plumbing contractor, Maritime Plumbing, to investigate and provide a solution to the problem.

On 12/17 Maritime Plumbing attempted to augur and clear the line. They discovered the line to be broken approximately 125' out from the clean-out opening. Upon deciding that the lateral msut be repaired, Maritime Plumbing contacted the City Inspection office and Diggger's Hotline to locate the lateral. Martime Plumbing was told by the city that the lateral extended from the building into State Street. Gulseth Excavating was hired to dig out the old lateral. Upon exposing the lateral piping, Maritime discovered that the piping was capped and abandoned. It was not functioning as the connection to the city system from the building.

Further consultation with the city produced the thought that the lateral entered the city system through N. 7th Street. Excavation of the street and sidewalk occurred where the city indicated, but no lateral was found.

Maritime Plumbing then contracted to Great Lakes to televise the main sewer line to locate the lateral entrance. This revealed the lateral to actually be 75' north of where the city indicated.

Upon location of the lateral, Maritime excavated the lateral, cleared and repaired the breaks and restored service to the building. The cost for this process is not a portion of this claim.

We are seeking reimbursement from the city of the costs to:

• Excavate and restore State Street - \$3,795.00

• Excavate and restore sidewalk and N. 7th Street in failed attempt to locate the lateral
