Dear Mayor and Common Council:

At the regular June 11, 2014 meeting of the Manitowoc City Plan Commission, the Commission reviewed the above referenced Petition for Annexation pursuant to <u>Wis. Stat.</u> § 66.0217(5) for 2.25-acres from the Town of Newton.

The Commission unanimously recommended that the Council approve the Petition as presented, and adopt an Annexation Ordinance.

The Commission further acknowledges that they have reviewed the proposed zoning classification for the annexation area, and recommend that the annexation area be zoned "R-4" Single-and Two-Family District in accordance with the attached map under <u>Wis. Stat.</u> § 66.0217(8)(a).

The Commission further notes that the proposed annexation has been reviewed by the Wisconsin Department of Administration (see attached) pursuant to <u>Wis. Stat.</u> § 66.0217(6)(a), and found to be in the public interest.



Subject: CHARLOTTE SOBEL ANNEXATION

The proposed annexation submitted to our office on May 12, 2014, has been reviewed and found to be in the public interest. In determining whether an annexation is in the public interest, s. 66.0217 (6), Wis. Stats. requires the Department to examine "[t]he shape of the proposed annexation and the homogeneity of the territory with the annexing village or city and any other contiguous village or city...." so as unincorporated land transitions to city or village status, the resulting boundaries are rational and easy for jurisdictions and residents to follow. The subject petition is for territory that is reasonably shaped and contiguous to the CITY OF MANITOWOC.

The Department reminds clerks of annexing municipalities of the requirements of s. 66.0217 (9)(a), Wis. Stats., which states:

"The clerk of a city or village which has annexed shall file immediately with the secretary of state a certified copy of the ordinance, certificate and plat, and shall send one copy to each company that provides any utility service in the area that is annexed. The clerk shall record the ordinance with the register of deeds and file a signed copy of the ordinance with the clerk of any affected school district..."

State and federal aids based on population and equalized value may be significantly affected through failure to file with the Secretary of State. Please file a copy of your annexing ordinance, including a statement certifying the population of the annexed territory. Please also include the MBR number with your ordinance as this assists with record keeping. Your MBR number is: 13777 The address of the Office of the Secretary of State is:
