This agreement is made and entered into by and between the Cities of Two Rivers and Manitowoc, Wisconsin, hereinafter called "City" and the above-named individual, hereinafter called "Permittee." The parties agree as follows: Bookings must be made no earlier than 12 months in advance. The Permittee understands his/her responsibility is to set up, clean up and restore premises within the time period listed above.

Limitation of Use: Permittee agrees that the number of persons on the rented premises during the rental period shall not exceed the capacity of the facility and that no intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverages shall be served to minors. Permittee agrees to use premises rented for the purpose stated above and no other. In the event this Limitation of Use is not complied with, Permittee shall be charged and agrees to pay a fee of \$200.

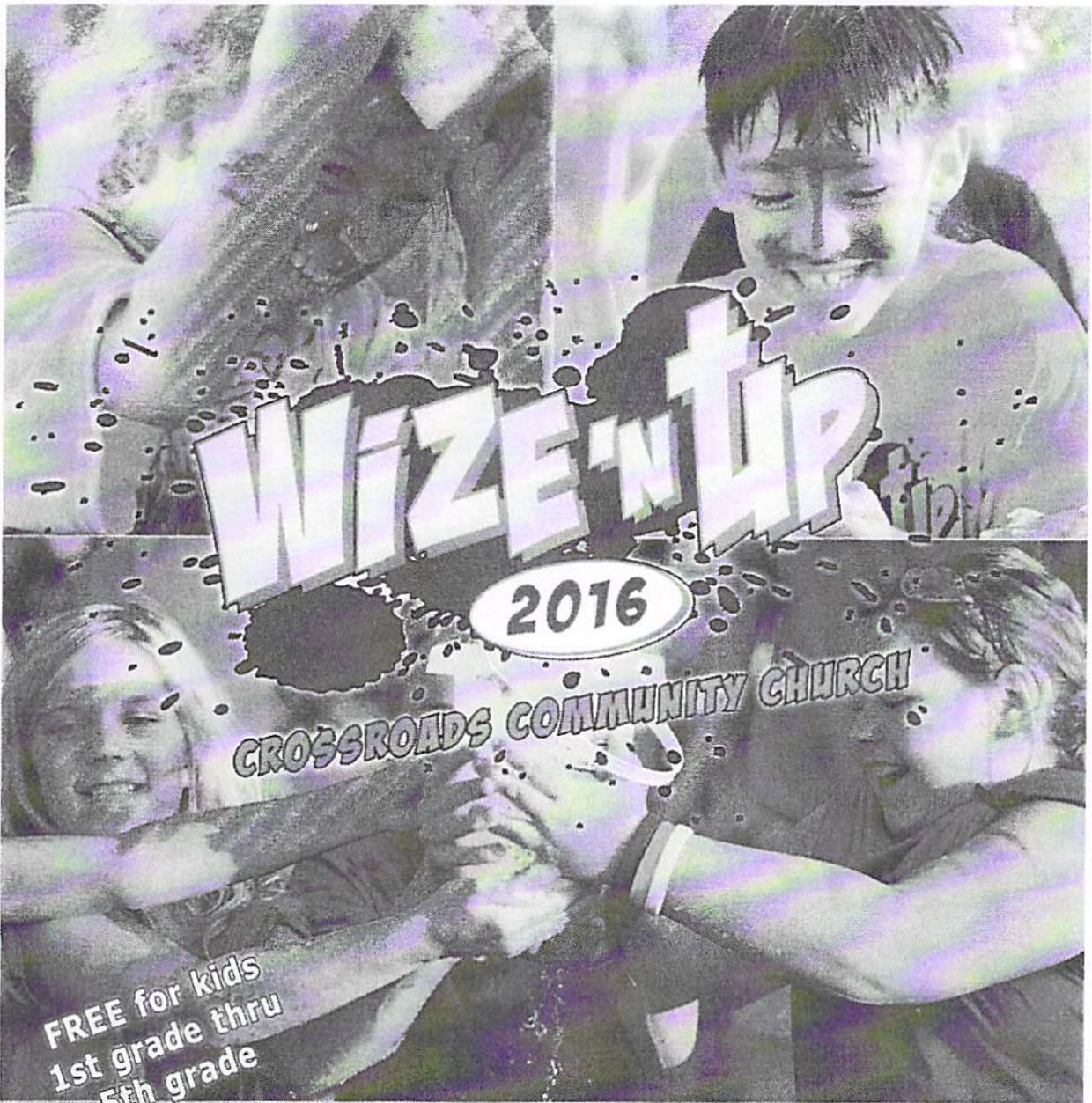

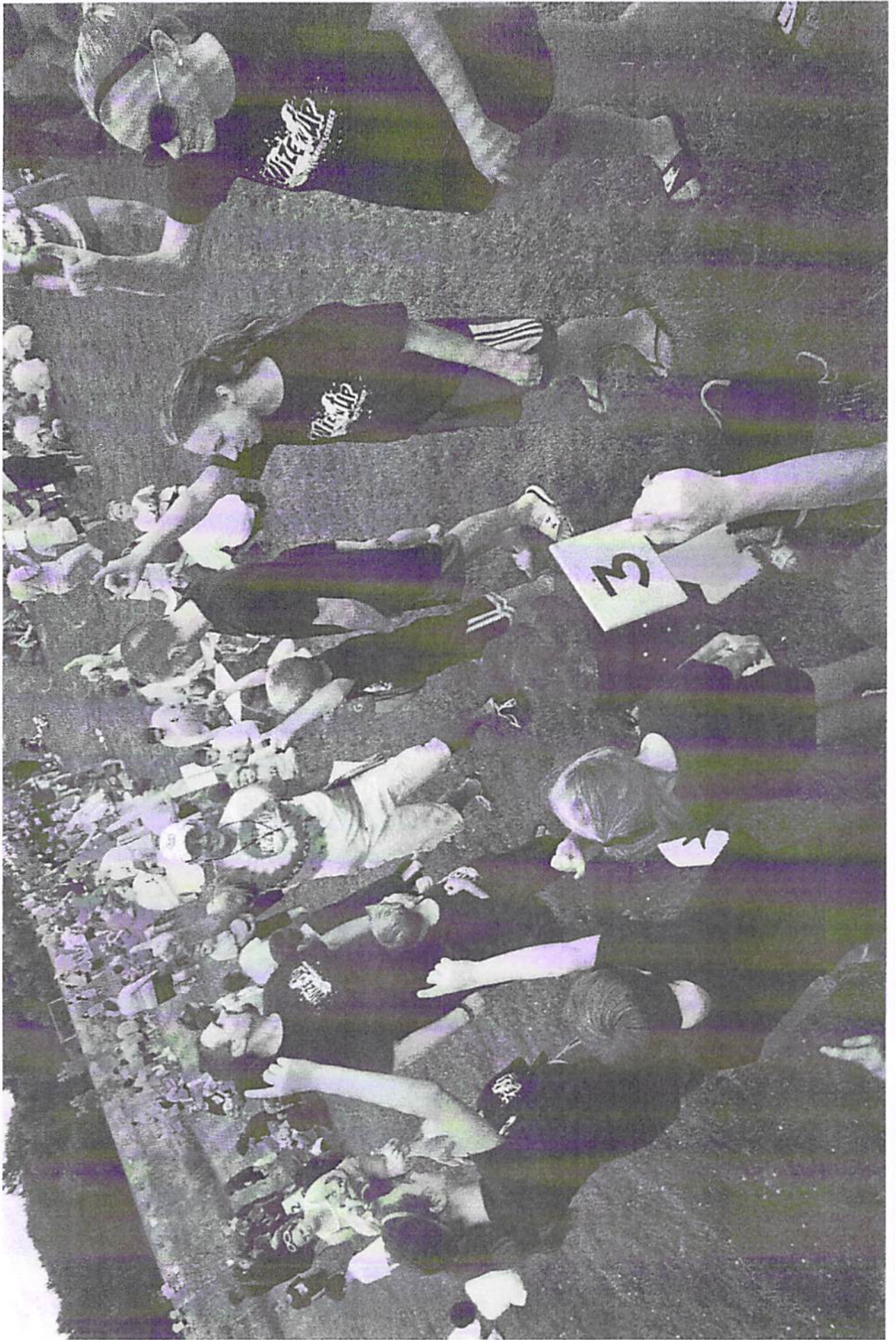










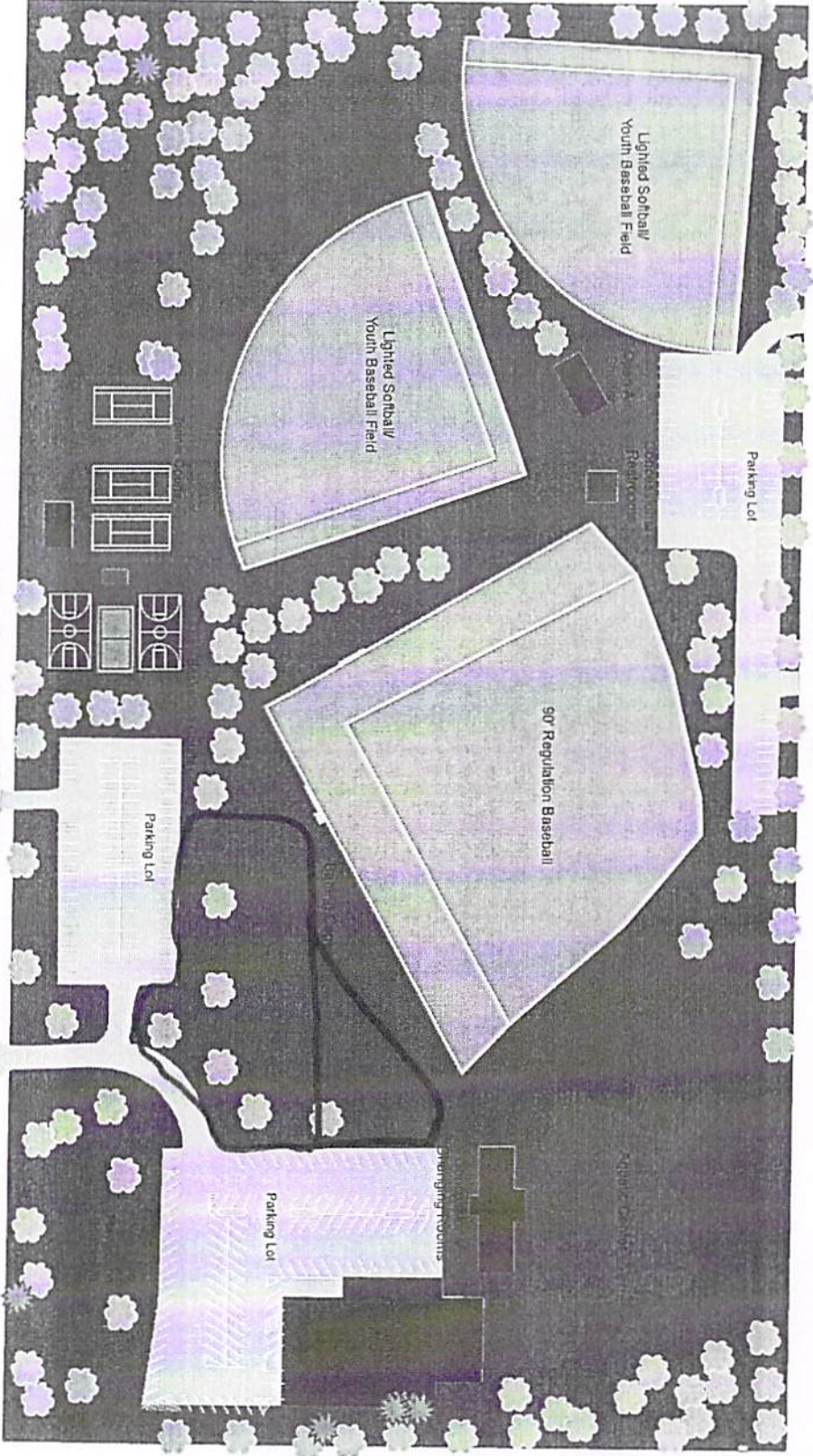

Hi Sandy,

I just wanted to give you a heads up on a Special Events Request that will be coming in soon. It is from Nick Stanislawski (920-285-7139) with the Crossroads Church of Manitowoc (*I made an acct for them in Activenet*).

He would like to use the Full Gym at CP on the following days/times for this event.

Set Up days: Aug 6<sup>th</sup> -9a-9p & Aug. 7<sup>th</sup> - 1:30-6p

Event Dates: Aug 8<sup>th</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup> 6pm – 10pm (actual event time is 6:15p-8:30p on those days, but need longer hours for cleanup)

This would be the first year holding it Manitowoc (normally held in Sheboygan). It's a free event for all area children. They use the gym for music, dance, activities etc. and then would need the green space (beyond diamond #1) for outdoor games. These outdoor games include having a slippery slide where they use applesauce or something of that consistency, pudding races etc. So the grass does get matted and messy. They would like access to water if possible to clean up as much as they can afterwards.

However, Denise wasn't sure if and when the construction will be beginning on the complex. So that was another thing. If he requests fees to be waived, our facility attendant fees still need to be paid.
