Proposal to change parking ordinance on S. 8<sup>th</sup> St.

## Reason:

In 2019, when the freshman class was moved into the Lincoln building, all buses pickup and drop off was moved from S. 8<sup>th</sup> St. to Green St. to accommodate the additional buses needed to for transport. This change has been positive and will continue. As a result, the old ordinance regulating parking on S. 8<sup>th</sup> St. for busing is outdated. I propose the below.

## **Reference Manitowoc City Ordinance 10.390**

(Current Ordinance) South 8th Street. There shall be no parking on South 8th Street as follows:

- (a) On either side of South 8th Street from the south curbline of Columbus Street extending 300 feet south, excluding school bus parking only on the east side of South 8th Street between 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. on school days.
- (b) On the east side of South 8th Street between Columbus and Madison Streets, excluding school bus parking between 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. on school days.
- (c) On the west side of South 8th Street between Columbus and Madison Streets from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. during school days.
- (d) On the east side of South 8th Street beginning at a point located 120 feet north of the north curbline of Madison Street, thence continuing north a distance of 30 feet, except for the sole purpose of loading and unloading motor vehicles.

## (Current Ordinance for S. 9<sup>th</sup> St. – example)

(g) On the west side of South 9th Street from Madison Street to Green Street between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. while Lincoln High School is in session (school days), except for the purpose of student drop-off or pickup, as noted in subsection (2) of this section.

## **Proposed:**

Discard:

S. 8<sup>th</sup> St. (b) and (c)

Add:

On the east side of South 8th Street from Madison Street to Columbus Street between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. while Lincoln High School is in session (school days).

Don't post anything on the west side of S. 8<sup>th</sup> St. between Madison and Columbus St., it would be normal parking, like anywhere else in the city.

The street is not wide enough to allow traffic in both directions if both sides of the street are parked full. Thereby impeding emergency traffic from easy access to the school if there was a vehicle traveling in the opposite direction.
