Your special events request for permission to have sidewalk sales on July 8 – 10, 2016 for Krazy Daze; and, further requesting (1) use of Burger Boat Park, (2) use of electrical outlets in Burger Park, (3) DJ on corner of S. 8<sup>th</sup> and Franklin Streets, and (4) Safety Patrol crossing guard at S. 8<sup>th</sup> and Quay and cones on S. 8<sup>th</sup>, was acted upon by the Special Events Committee on May 9 2016. At said meeting the Committee unanimously approved your request.

Please note that 40" of sidewalk must be passable to allow for safe pedestrian and wheelchair movement.

Committee states you must submit insurance by June 1<sup>st</sup>. Please have your insurance agent submit a certificate of insurance along with additional insured endorsement to my office to evidence your organization's liability insurance coverage. To expedite, please fax to 920-686-6959 or e-mail to dneuser@manitowoc.org. Special Events Insurance Requirements are also enclosed.

All vendors must have a direct seller permit which can be obtained from the City Clerk's Office at City Hall, except for 1) vendors selling prepared food and/or beverages for immediate consumption; 2) any person selling goods or services at a flea market, art fair or similar event involving five or more direct sellers and sponsored by a permanent resident of Manitowoc County.

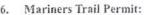

Set up / take down and clean up, as well as other services provided by a City staff may be billed on a cost-recovery basis. The event organizer must provide a copy of event liability insurance naming BOTH CITIES as co-insured at least 10 days prior to the event. Permits do not allow "exclusive use" of the trail and the general public must be allowed to share the permitted areas.

This agreement is made and entered into by and between the Cities of Two Rivers and Manitowoc, Wisconsin, hereinafter called "City" and the above-named individual, hereinafter called "Permittee." The parties agree as follows: Bookings must be made no earlier than 12 months in advance. The Permittee understands his/her responsibility is to set up, clean up and restore premises within the time period listed above.

	Limitation of User Permittee agrees that the number of persons on the rented premises during the rental period shall not exceed the capacity of the facility and that no intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverages shall be served to minors. Permittee agrees to use premises rented for the purpose stated above and no other. In the event this Limitation of Use is not complied with, Permittee shall be charged and agrees to pay a fee of \$206.
