In addition to drafting legislation and reviewing contracts as requested by City departments, the City Attorney's Office has worked on the following projects and initiatives since my last update dated December 1st, 2022:

Environmental Remediation

- Lemberger Landfill: Work continues as planned. I have taken the lead going forward.
- Gravel Pit: Godfrey Kahn continues as legal counsel. Watermain project continues.
- Mirro Plant No. 9: Godfrey Kahn is legal counsel for cost recovery efforts.
- WPS Superfund Site: No update.

Monthly Reporting on Workload
