

ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to amend the Bond Schedule for certain violations of Chapter 10, Traffic Regulations, Section 11.030, Adult Entertainment Taverns, and Chapter 14, Offenses Against Public Policy, Safety, Morals and Peace.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

Section 1. 11.030(4) Registration of Adult Entertainers. Penalties for violating Section 11.030(4) shall be as follows:

Section 4. 14.130(1) Disorderly Conduct. Penalties for violating Section 14.130(1)(a) and (b) shall be as follows:

Section 5. 14.130(2) Disorderly Conduct Causing Injury. Penalties for violating Section 14.130(2) shall be as follows:

$$\del{\$255 + cc = \$382.30} \quad \underline{\$325 + cc = \$470.50}$$

Section 6. 14.130(3) Compression Brakes Prohibited

Penalties for violating Section 14.130(3) shall be as follows:

$$\del{\$130 + cc = \$224.80}$$

$$\underline{\$175 + cc = \$281.50}$$

Section 7. 14.160 Unlawful Use of Telephone, Cell Phone, Computerized Communication System

Penalties for violating Section 14.160 shall be as follows:

$$\del{\$130 + cc = \$224.80} \quad \underline{\$140 + cc = \$237.40}$$

Section 8. 14.300 Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Penalties for violating Section 14.300 shall be as follows:

$$\del{\$150.00 + cc = \$250.00} \quad \underline{\$200 + cc = \$313.00}$$

Section 9. 14.460(1) Obstructing an Officer. Penalties for violating Section 14.460(1) shall be as follows:

$$\del{\$120 + cc = \$212.20} \quad \underline{\$175 + cc = \$281.50}$$

Section 10. 14.460(1) Resisting an Officer

Penalties for violating Section 14.460(1) shall be as follows:

Section 11. 10.390 Parking Prohibited

Penalties for violating Section 10.390 shall be ~~\$15.00~~ \$20.00

Section 12. 10.390(2) Parking Within a School Zone

Penalties for violating Section 10.390(2) shall be ~~\$15.00~~ \$20.00

Section 13. 10.390(11) Parking on Private Property

Penalties for violating Section 10.390(11) shall be ~~\$15.00~~ \$20.00

Section 14. 10.430 Parking Regulations for Street Sweeping and Fall Leaf Pickup

Penalties for violating Section 10.430 shall be ~~\$15.00~~ \$20.00

Section 15. 10.470 One-Hour Parking

Penalties for violating Section 10.470 shall be ~~\$15.00~~ \$20.00

Section 16. 10.490 Two-Hour Parking

Penalties for violating Section 10.490 shall be ~~\$15.00~~ \$20.00

Section 17. 10.530 Twenty-Four-Hour Parking

Penalties for violating Section 10.530 shall be ~~\$15.00~~ \$20.00

Section 18. 10.670(8)(1) Traffic Bureau Parking Regulations

Penalties for violating Section 10.670(8)(1) shall be ~~\$15.00~~ \$20.00

Section 19. This ordinance shall take effect the day after publication.
