

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is expedient and necessary and in the best interest of the City of Manitowoc that certain infrastructure improvements be included in the 2017 Public Works Program.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANITOWOC, that the work listed below be included in the 2017 Street Improvement, Sanitary and Storm Sewer, and Miscellaneous Program, and that the Board of Public Works is herewith authorized and instructed to prepare plans and specifications and advertise for bids for work on these streets and miscellaneous projects.

CONCRETE PAVING

1. South 10th Street – Dewey Street to Viebahn Street
2. South 35th Street – Calumet Avenue to approximately 180 feet South.
3. Concrete Slab Replacement – Various Locations

ASPHALTIC CONCRETE RESURFACING AND OVERLAY

1. Springhill Drive – Woodlawn Drive to approx. 1,925 feet southwest
2. Alley #23 Bounded by Reed Ave., Magnolia Ave., N. 7th & N. 8th St.
3. Edgewood Lane – W. Custer Street to approx. 140 feet West of Brookfield Circle.
4. Mariners Trail – Replacement/Upgrade from E. Reed Ave. to approx. 800 feet South.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that due to all necessary underground work having to be installed prior to paving, that the Board of Public Works is herewith authorized to prepare plans and specifications, and advertise for bids for the installation of necessary underground work in this 2017 Infrastructure Program; that the proper legal notices be posted, and that the City Clerk is herewith authorized and instructed to advertise for bids covering any underground work not begun within the legal time limit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the abutting property will be assessed, per foot, per side, where applicable pursuant to the Wisconsin Statutes and the Municipal Code of the City of Manitowoc.
