

**R E S O L U T I O N**

**MODIFYING THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR  
BUILDING INSPECTION DIVISION OF LIFE SAFETY AND  
NEIGHBORHOOD SERVICES DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Manitowoc (City) has long collected fees for various services in order to defray some of the costs associated with providing same; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City previously established a fee schedule for building, electrical, mechanical, plumbing and sign inspection activities; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to implement a fee schedule for blight-elimination and code enforcement inspection activities in order to meet the City’s goals of eliminating blight, improving housing stock and reducing nuisances; and,

**WHEREAS**, by establishing a fee schedule for such inspections, the City will be better able to defray the costs of the program.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by Mayor Justin M. Nickels and the Common Council of the City of Manitowoc that the Fire Department Life Safety Division Fee Schedule be adopted as attached.
