WHEREAS, all recitals from the Animal Loan Agreement between FARM BUREAU and CITY shall be incorporated herein by reference and shall become a part of this agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

I. **SCOPE OF AGREEMENT.** CITY has created the Big Red Barn at the ZOO for the care and shelter of farm animal(s). OWNER, as a member farmer of the FARM BUREAU, agrees to loan to CITY 2-pigs for the 2016 season commencing May 22, 2016, and ending September 5, 2016, for the ZOO's Big Red Barn exhibit. OWNER acknowledges that FARM BUREAU has entered into an agreement with CITY for the loan of said farm animal(s) and farmer acknowledges and understands that all the terms, conditions and covenants in the FARM BUREAU agreement with the CITY are incorporated by reference into this agreement and understands those terms control this agreement.

A. OWNER shall:

1. Provide healthy young, disease free animal(s) to be used at the ZOO.
2. Abide by all Federal, State and Local Laws which relate to farm animals and the terms of this Agreement.
3. Transport and deliver animal(s) to CITY ZOO without charge to CITY, and shall give CITY employees clear and concise verbal and written instructions as to the care and feeding of the animals at no charge to the CITY.
4. If the animal(s) mature(s) rapidly and becomes too large, or it is determined by CITY to be unsafe to continue housing said animal(s) at the ZOO, OWNER shall retrieve said animal(s) within five (5) calendar days of receiving written notice from the CITY.
5. Be responsible for all medical treatment, veterinarian care, husbandry, immobilization, or relocation of animal(s) loaned to CITY, and all medical decisions shall be at the OWNER's sole discretion.
6. Pickup and transport said animal(s) at the end of the season, or earlier as deemed necessary by the CITY, with final pickup being no later than September 12, 2010.
7. Assume all risk regarding said animals, including risk of loss, and costs of delivery, pickup and transporting of said animal(s). Farmer shall hold the City, its employees,


officers, committees and agents harmless for any loss, damage or injury to the animal while in the care, custody and control of ZOO.

3. Maintain a safe environment within the ZOO for said animal(s).
4. Notify farmer within twenty-four (24) hours of any births, hatching of offspring, serious illness, escape (even if recaptured) and mortality of any animal loaned to CITY.
5. Not transfer any animal(s) on loan to another location or party beyond the contiguous boundaries of the ZOO without written permission of the farmer, except in an emergency.
6. CITY shall not allow any invasive or stressful research on animal(s) loaned by farmer.
7. At the end of the season, CITY shall turn over to farmer all data accumulated on the animal(s) on loan during the term of this Agreement.

II. ANIMAL WARRANTY. OWNER warrants that he/she owns the animal(s) being loan to the ZOO. OWNER shall indemnify and hold harmless CITY, its employees, officers, committees and agents, for any loss, cost, claim, damage, action or expense, including attorney fees incurred as a result of a third party claim of possession, title or interest in whole or in part, to said animal(s).
