Subject: Future Plans for USH 151 Calumet Ave. and Washington St.

Hi Mark,

I am not sure if you are the correct person to be writing to on this issue. (It appears that Scott Simmons and Anne Ebent are no longer with DOT or my e-mail addresses are outdated).

Anyway, the City of Manitowoc would like to know what the DOT has planned for future improvements to USH 151 (Washington St. from S. 8th St. to S. 26th St. and Calumet Ave. from S. 26th St. to S. 41st St.

This entire corridor is getting to be in pretty tough shape, especially Washington St. from S. 15th to S. 26th St.

The DOT resurfaced this corridor in 2001 (Washington St.) and 2003 (Calumet Ave.). The resurfaced asphalt pavement is nearing the end of its useful life.

The City's Public Infrastructure Committee will be discussing this corridor at their meeting next week.

It is possible that the City will be drafting a resolution to request the DOT to start looking at programming improvements to this corridor.

Is there a standard procedure for requesting these types of projects. If so, please let me know. Thanks.

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
