RE. Small rest room building at Red Arrow Park

The condition of the small restroom building at Red Arrow Park has fallen below acceptable standards. I am recommending that we raze it. This building is the oldest free-standing restroom building in our Parks System. Adjacent to the lakefront parking lot is a more modern building that would meet the needs of this park.

The cost to remodel is conservatively estimated to be \$19,000. It needs new doors, windows, toilet partitions, and plumbing fixtures. The interior wall surfaces should be covered in fiberglass panels and the floor should be scarified and sealed. The exterior needs to be pressure washed, tuck-pointed and sealed.

The cost of razing is around \$4,000. I have checked with the Parks Manager and the Recreation Manager and they both agree that this building can be razed without undue inconvenience to the public. Please see the attached report.






