Re: Sex Offender Residence Appeal for Placement at the Department of Corrections Transitional Housing Service

Subject: Wuellner, Jason L.

Mr. Jason Wuellner is scheduled to be released from prison on extended supervision on 05/10/16. He stands convicted of Cause Child 13-18 to View Sexual Activity in violation of Wisconsin State Statute(s) 948.055(1). Mr. Wuellner lived in Two Rivers when he committed his offense. Upon release from the Wisconsin Prison System, he will be indigent, with no residence or familial support to rely upon.

Prior to the sex offender residence ordinance, agents in the Manitowoc Probation/Parole Office routinely utilized the Transitional Housing Service for placement of registered sex offenders transitioning from prison back into the community. Due to the sex offender residence ordinance in the City of Manitowoc, Mr. Wuellner is not currently permitted to reside here.

At this time, I am requesting approval to allow Mr. Wuellner to reside at 1118A South 19th Street, the Department of Correction's Transitional Housing Service residence, until he is able to secure a permanent residence. Per Department policy, Mr. Wuellner would only be allowed to stay at the residence for a period of up to 90 days; this residence is intended for the temporary placement of individuals on supervision as they transition into more stable/suitable housing.
