NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc to approve renaming and reclassifying the Community Service Worker position, currently in this role, to a Community Service Worker Supervisor/Fleet Maintenance position, along with the attached revised job description, as an exempt, salaried position at Grade G, effective January 1, 2023, according to the Compensation Plan and Employee Policy Manual, and the Mayor's approved 2023 Executive Budget.
