I looked at this area last night. The employees are parking on the west side of N. 8th St. immediately south of the Eck Driveway. There were 2 cars parked in that spot last night.

This is the area that used to have railroad tracks going through it, so no one ever parked there. However, since the tracks came out in 2012 with the asphalt resurfacing project and curb was put in the area across the former track location people are allowed to park there.

I have attached 2 photos from 2011 when the railroad tracks were there. I see that there was no parking between signs in this same area. I would assume it was so that no one parked near the tracks.

I talked to Eric Cayemberg this morning and we both agreed that the recommendation to the Public Safety (PS) Committee should be 'No Parking from Eck's driveway to 100 feet south.

He is planning to attend the PS Comm. Meeting on Monday at 6 pm.

Basically, we would be just re-implementing what used to be out there.

There would still be approximately 140 feet of parking available between the last Eck No Parking sign and the 1st no parking sign for Cawley Co. area.
