Hello Everyone,

I received a call from a resident of the Artist Lofts Apartment building today who is having problems with parking tickets especially during our Street Sweeping No Parking Day.

From what my constituent told me, he has two vehicles. Under the terms of their lease, they are allowed one parking space inside the building and the outside lot is first come first serve. He works until 1:30 AM so by the time he gets home from work, the outside lot is generally full. Since I live right up the block from Artist Lofts, I see this everyday and the 2400 block of Franklin Street is generally full with vehicles. Six days of the week it is not a problem but with Wednesday being the day of the street sweeping ordinance, from 3:00 AM until 6:00 AM many people are receiving parking tickets. With the fall leaf parking ban about to go into effect next week, it will continue until at least the middle of November.

From my understanding, my constituent spoke with Assistant Chief Barbier today about the situation. He referred him to me. His request is that this block (2400 Franklin Street) become exempt from the Street Sweeping and Leaf Pick Up Parking Ordinance.

Although I am not sure that this is the best way to address this I am requesting Alderman Schlei as Chairman of the Public Safety Committee that you allow this to be put on your agenda for discussion at your October 11th Public Safety Committee meeting.
