

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is expedient and necessary and in the best interest of the City of Manitowoc that certain infrastructure improvements be included in the 2020 Public Works Program.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANITOWOC, that the work listed below be included in the 2020 Street Improvement, Sanitary and Storm Sewer, and Miscellaneous Program, and that the Board of Public Works is herewith authorized and instructed to prepare plans and specifications and advertise for bids for work on these streets and miscellaneous projects.

CONCRETE PAVING

1. Bayshore Drive – Waldo Boulevard to E. Reed Avenue (T.I.F. Project)
2. Waldo Blvd. – North 14th Street to N. Rapids Rd. (DOT Project)
3. Maritime Drive – North 6th Street to Buffalo Street
4. Roneta Lane – 140 ft. of new pavement west of Cappaert Rd.
5. South 13th Street – Franklin Street to Washington Street
6. South 29th Street – Meadow Lane to Coolidge Place
7. Concrete Slab Replacement – Various Locations

ASPHALTIC CONCRETE RECONSTRUCTION AND RESURFACING

1. CTH “CL” (Hecker Road) – Calumet Avenue to Viebahn Street (County Project)
2. East Crescent Drive – Waldo Boulevard to West Crescent Drive

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the abutting property will be assessed, per foot, per side, where applicable pursuant to the Wisconsin Statutes and the Municipal Code of the City of Manitowoc.
