

STIPULATION AND ORDER FOR DISMISSAL WITH LEAVE TO REINSTATE

WHEREAS, Plaintiff, UnitedOne Credit Union ("Plaintiff") and Defendant, Rick L. Salta ("Defendant") are parties to the above-captioned litigation; and

WHEREAS, Plaintiff filed the above-captioned foreclosure action in Manitowoc County on March 22, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Plaintiff and Defendant have settled the matter pursuant to a Settlement Agreement dated November 30, 2013, as amended (the "Settlement Agreement").

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between Plaintiff and Defendant as follows:

1. Defendant, Rick L. Salta shall make payments to Plaintiff UnitedOne Credit Union in the total amount of \$600,000.00 (the "Settlement Amount") upon the terms and conditions outlined in the Settlement Agreement.

- 2. The above-captioned litigation shall be dismissed without prejudice and without costs to any party, and, in the event the Defendant has defaulted under the Settlement Agreement, leave to allow the Plaintiff to reinstate this Case and pursue recourse under the Settlement Agreement including but not limited to entry of a judgment (the "Judgment") including the following: (i) ordering default judgment against all defendants in the case who have failed to appear as demonstrated by the Affidavit of Timothy A. Burkard, filed herewith, (ii) ordering foreclosure and sale of all properties in the Case at Sheriff's Sale in accordance with applicable law and the pleadings on file in this Case, (iii) pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, entering a stipulated judgment against Defendant, Rick L. Salta, for the Settlement Amount less any payments Defendant has made on the Settlement Amount, plus interest from the date of the Settlement Agreement to the date of the Judgment at the fixed rate of 8% per annum, additional interest costs, reasonable attorneys' fees, and the amount of any protective advances made by Plaintiff to Defendant from the date hereof, and (iv) such other relief as the Court may order.
- 3. The Mortgages and Assignments of Rents and Leases identified in the Complaint shall continue to secure Defendant's obligations under the Notes and the Settlement Amount.
- 4. This Stipulation amends and supersedes the terms of the Settlement Agreement to the extent necessary to bring the Settlement Agreement into compliance with this Stipulation and the Court's Order.
- 5. In entering into this Stipulation, Plaintiff and Defendant represent and warrant that each have done so voluntarily, have had an opportunity to consult with legal counsel and such other advisors as each determines necessary, and have relied upon their own judgment regarding the proper, complete and agreed to consideration and the language of this Stipulation, and that no statements or representations made by the other party or any of its agents, employees or counsel has influenced or induced any party to execute this Stipulation.

4. The parties agree that the existence and execution of this Stipulation and the performance of the obligations imposed in the Settlement Agreement constitute nothing other than an accommodation and compromise and does not constitute an admission of liability or non-liability, breach of performance of any duties or obligations or any other wrongdoing of any

nature whatsoever. Except for the obligations undertaken by the parties herein, each party denies

any and all liability to each other.

5. This Stipulation may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument.

6. This Stipulation is binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto

and their respective successors, assigns and legal representatives.

7. The Circuit Court for Manitowoc County shall have exclusive jurisdiction to hear

any and all disputes regarding enforcement of the terms and conditions of this Stipulation and the

Settlement Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Plaintiff and Rick L. Salta have caused their duly authorized

representatives to execute this Stipulation as of the dates set forth below.
