ORDINANCE

An ordinance to amend Section 10.440 of the Manitowoc Municipal Code, revising parking regulations for spring clean-up and fall brush pick-up.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 10.440 is created to read as follows:

"10.440. Parking Regulations for Spring Clean-Up and Fall Brush Pick-Up. (1) Duration. The spring clean-up and fall brush pick-up shall be for a period of one week for each section or district. The spring clean-up and fall brush pick-up shall be Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 3:00 P.M.

- (2) Maps. The Spring Clean-Up and Fall Brush Pick-Up maps shall be prepared and maintained by the Director of Public Infrastructure and kept on file as public records in the office of the City Engineer, copies of which shall be distributed to the members of the Council and filed with the Council.
- (3) Sections for Spring Clean-Up. The spring clean-up maps shall divide the City into areas or sections in which the spring clean-up shall be done as herein specified, and during which time no vehicles, trailers, boats, dumpsters, or other obstructions shall be parked on the street in a manner which interferes with the pickup of yard waste, Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 3:00 P.M. for the streets set forth herein, and as more specifically described below:

Section 1: West of North 18th Street and north of the Manitowoc River.

<u>Section 2:</u> West of the Canadian National Railroad Tracks and south of the Manitowoc River.

<u>Section 3:</u> East of the Canadian National Railroad Tracks and south of the Manitowoc River.

Section 4: East of North 18th Street and north of the Manitowoc River.

(4) Sections for Fall Brush Pick-Up. The fall brush pick-up maps shall divide the City into areas or sections in which the fall brush pick-up shall be done as herein specified, and during which time no vehicles, trailers, boats, dumpsters, or other obstructions shall be parked on the street in a manner which interferes with brush pickup, Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 3:00 P.M. for the streets set forth herein, and as more specifically described below:

Northside: The area north of the Manitowoc River

Southside: The area south of the Manitowoc River.

(5) Notice. The dates for the spring clean up and fall brush pick-up shall be published one time in the Herald Times Reporter one week before implementation. The Director of Public Infrastructure shall also issue a press release to local media and cause the City's social media to be updated. Citations. Citations will only be issued if a motor vehicle, trailer, boat, dumpster or other obstruction is parked in a manner which interferes with brush or yard waste pickup."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication.
