ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to amend Section 10.390 of the Manitowoc Municipal Code regulating Parking on Marshall Street.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 10.390 is amended to read as follows:

“10.390 Parking Prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to park such vehicle in any of the places where parking is prohibited by Wis. Stat. Ch. 346, except to comply with the directions of a traffic officer or traffic control signal or sign, or to park upon any portion of the following designated streets or places:

...

Marshall Street. There shall be no parking on Marshall Street as follows:

~~(e) On the south side of Marshall Street from the west curblane of South 15th Street for a distance of 149 feet to the west.~~

~~(f)~~(e) There shall be no parking on either side of Marshall Street from the east crosswalk line of South 26th Street easterly for a distance of 115 feet.

~~(g)~~(f) On the south side of Marshall Street from the west curblane of South 20th Street for a distance of 49 feet to the west.

~~(h)~~(g) On the south side of Marshall Street beginning at a point 145 feet west of the west curblane of South 8th Street, thence continuing west for a distance of 55 feet.

...”

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after publication.
