Your request to host HFM Maritime Marathon on June 12, 2016, for a timed running race from UW Manitowoc to Point Beach State Forest, as well as the use of the Mariner's Trail, was acted upon by the Special Events Committee at their meeting of Monday, April 4, 2016.

At said meeting, the Committee approved your request and agreed not to lift bridges during the event and approved the use of traffic control items. As a condition of approval, you will need to meet with Police, Fire and Streets personnel for traffic control prior to the event.

Permits do not allow "exclusive use" of the trail and the general public must be allowed to share the permitted areas.
