DEPUTY FIRE CHIEFS, KARL KOCH & GREGG KADOW

WHEREAS, on December 9, 2014, the Police and Fire Commission of the City of Manitowoc approved the Fire Department re-organization appointing Battalion Chief Karl Koch to the position of Deputy Fire Chief for the City of Manitowoc in 2015; and,

WHEREAS, the Personnel Committee of the City of Manitowoc has recommended the pay schedule as set forth below for Fire Chief Todd Blaser with restructuring of the department, at a meeting held on Tuesday, February 3, 2015; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc that the recommendation of the Police and Fire Commission and the Personnel Committee to appoint Battalion Chief Karl Koch as Deputy Fire Chief for the City of Manitowoc is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc that Deputy Fire Chief Karl Koch be placed at Grade P of the Compensation Pay Plan, as an exempt salaried position with an annual rate of \$77,632, and is eligible for a Step increase in July 2015; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc that Deputy Fire Chief Gregg Kadow remain at Grade P of the Compensation Pay Plan, as an exempt salaried position move to Step 6 with an annual rate of \$79,123, and is not eligible for a step increase in July 2015; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the restructuring of the Fire Department be approved, as outlined on the attachment, effective upon passage of this resolution by the Mayor and Common Council.


