# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

# LITTLE MANITOWOC RIVER COASTAL WETLAND RESTORATION PROJECT DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION

#### I. THE PARTIES

- 1.01 The City of Manitowoc, a Wisconsin municipal corporation, doing business at 900 Quay Street, Manitowoc, Wisconsin, 54220. ("City").
- 1.02 Lakeshore Natural Resource Partnership, Inc., a Wisconsin non-profit association ("LNRP"), with a mailing address of P.O. Box 358, Cleveland, WI 53015.

#### II. THE RECITALS

#### WHEREAS,

- 2.01 The City owns portions of the natural land and waterway in and abutting the Little Manitowoc River as shown on the map labeled as Exhibit "A".
- 2.02 The LNRP has identified the need for the restoration of this estuary due to the large rainfall events and severe flooding that took place in June of 2008.
- 2.03 The City's Parks & Recreation Committee endorsed this project at their meeting on May 26, 2015 and requested staff and LNRP to continue moving forward with the project.
- 2.04 The LNRP has received grant funding from the Fund for Lake Michigan, USFWS, the West Foundation, and the Sustain our Great Lakes to finance all aspects of the construction of the Little Manitowoc River Estuary Restoration Project.
- 2.05 LNRP anticipates completing the Little Manitowoc River Estuary Restoration Project in 2018. At the time of this Agreement, the total construction cost is estimated to \$420,000.
- 2.06 LNRP and the City acknowledge that there will be future maintenance costs and accordingly, sufficient funds will need to be raised to create and support a long-term maintenance fund.
- 2.06 LNRP and the City acknowledge that there will be future maintenance costs and accordingly, sufficient resources will need to be raised to create and support a long-term maintenance program. LNRP will channel funds and volunteer resources through their local partner, the Friends of the Manitowoc River Watershed.

2.07 The City will support LNRP's efforts to design and construct the Little Manitowoc River Estuary Restoration Project subject to LNRP meeting each of the various terms and conditions of this Agreement.

#### III. THE AGREEMENT

## NOW, THEREFORE,

- 3.01 The recitals are hereby made a part of the Agreement.
- 3.02 The LNRP shall provide to the City a copy of its grant approval letters.
- 3.03 The LNRP shall be responsible for obtaining all required agency permits for the construction project, including but not limited to DNR and USACOE, and all permit fees.
- 3.04 The City shall allow LNRP access to Waldo Blvd. for the purposes of ingress and egress for materials, equipment, etc.
- 3.05 The LNRP shall provide to the City, on at least a quarterly basis, reports of the LNRP's progress, including but not limited to, minutes of Board meetings and updated accountings of their grant funds.
- 3.06 LNRP shall submit, for approval by the City, a detailed project plan that includes, but is not necessarily limited to, proposed designs for the project, project specifications and material, labor, administrative costs. Additionally, LNRP shall also submit a long-term maintenance plan detailing scheduled maintenance. This long-term plan shall account for estimated costs for routine and scheduled maintenance. The City reserves the right to request supplemental information, supporting documentation or any other information it deems necessary to evaluate these plans.
- 3.06.1 LNRP shall provide the City with copies of all costs, invoices, as-built drawings, labor costs, contract documents and specifications, inspection and design documentation and all contract administration supporting documentation and an itemized list of all expenses and any estimates for the value of in-kind services for the design and construction of the Little Manitowoc River Coastal Wetland Restoration Project within thirty (30) days of completion.
- 3.07 Sufficient funding for the entire project shall be on deposit in the Account prior to beginning any construction. For purposes hereof, "sufficient funding" shall be an amount equal to the total cost of the project and all associated amenities contained in the final proposal submitted to the LNRP by a general contractor that has an approved current "Bidders Proof of Responsibility" on file with the City Clerk and with the approval of the City of Manitowoc. The LNRP agrees to provide promptly any and all estimates and proposals received from general contractors to the City.

- 3.08 LNRP shall provide the City with copies of lien waivers for all contractors, subcontractors and suppliers involved in the construction. Upon completion of construction, and upon being free and clear of all liens, encumbrances and the like, ownership of the facility shall be transferred, in writing, to the City.
- 3.09 The terms of this Agreement may only be modified, waived or abandoned by written agreement signed by both parties.

#### IV. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

4.01 In the event that any part of this Agreement is found to be illegal, it shall be stricken from the Agreement and the Agreement interpreted as if that clause did not exist.

#### V. INDEMNIFICATION CLAUSE

- 5.01 The LNRP agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City and its officers, officials, employees and agents from and against any and all liability, loss, damage expense, costs (including attorney fees) arising out of this agreement, caused by the LNRP, its officers, officials, employees, agents or anyone for whose acts they may be liable.
- 5.02 The City agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the LNRP and its officers, members and agents from and against any and all liability, loss, damage expense, costs (including attorney fees arising out of this Agreement), caused by the City, its officers, officials, employees, agents or anyone for whose acts it may be liable.

Rich and Jim,

Please see the attached Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). I think that this would be the document we should use for the City to authorize LNRP to do the work on the City's land.

The MOU is based on one that we used for the Miracle League Baseball Field at Dewey St. Park and is now renamed Miracles Park. This project was similar to our current project in that the Miracle League Group did everything on their own, including the construction, project management, etc. The City just took ownership of it after completion. That is pretty much what is happening here other than there is not a facility or building with this project.

I took a shot at the MOU. See what you think. The highlighted areas are where I had issues as to the language and whether or not it applies in this case.

We never talked about any long term maintenance needs or requirements and maybe there are none known at this time. Perhaps, this language just gets eliminated/removed.

We have not run this past our City Attorney yet. We wanted your input first and then give it to her. Once she approves it, we would take it to our PI Committee and the Common Council.
