

Tiered Parking Ordinance

Minimum forfeiture amounts for violations of MMC 10.410, 10.430, and 10.410(2) shall increase in value as specified by Parking Violation Table within six (6) consecutive months. Minimum forfeiture amounts for violations of MMC 10.390(2) shall increase in value until the fourth violation where upon a traffic citation shall be issued pursuant to § Wis. Stat. 346.53(6) specified by said Table within twelve (12) consecutive months. Whenever any vehicle shall have been parked in violation of this these, the person in whose name such vehicle is registered shall be prima facie responsible for such violation and subject to the penalty.

10.610 Parking Penalties**Revision**

(1) Any person violating MMC 10.470, 10.490, 10.510, 10.550 or 10.690* shall be required to forfeit not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$40.00. Any person violating MMC 10.810 shall be required to forfeit not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$200.00. Whenever any vehicle shall have been parked in violation of this chapter, the person in whose name such vehicle is registered shall be prima facie responsible for such violation and subject to the penalty therefor. If the vehicle involved in the parking violation is owned by a person engaged in a business of renting or leasing motor vehicles, the procedure for collecting the parking penalty shall be prescribed as in Wis. Stat. Ch. 345. Any person violating any other parking provision of this chapter, including portions of the Wisconsin Statutes adopted by reference, shall be required to forfeit not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00.

(2) In addition to any parking penalties, the Police Department shall charge \$5.00 per day for the storage of any vehicles which the Police Department impounds.

(3) In addition to accumulated fees for delayed payment of parking penalties, after forty five (45) days of the initial offense, the Police Department shall charge a \$10.00 processing fee in addition to a \$5.00 Department of Transportation suspension fee.

10.630 Towing of Motor Vehicles

(6) When a vehicle is subject to an outstanding balance of \$400.00 or more in parking tickets and additional fees issued by the City of Manitowoc, the vehicle may be considered in habitual violation of the parking ordinances until such time that all outstanding parking tickets are paid in full. Further, upon a subsequent violation, a vehicle considered to be in habitual violation of the parking ordinance pursuant to sections 10.390-10.550 may be towed and impounded at the owner's expense.

(7) A person wishing his/her vehicle to be released must provide identification and a receipt showing all outstanding parking citations are paid in full, including the citation for which the towing occurred as well as any towing, storage, or administration fee assessed pursuant to subsection (3) of this section. Whenever all such charges are paid, the vehicle shall be released to its owner. If a citation upon which removal and storage is authorized is released by the chief of police or his duly authorized representative or dismissed by the court because the citation was improperly issued, the chief of police or his duly authorized representative shall release the vehicle without payment of charges for removal and storage and shall refund any charges for removal and storage of such vehicle which shall have previously been paid.

OR

(7) Upon the towing of a vehicle due to habitual violations of parking ordinances, a person wishing his vehicle to be released must provide identification and a receipt showing all outstanding parking citations are paid in full, including the citation for which the towing occurred as well as any towing, storage, or administration fee assessed pursuant to subsection (3) of this section. Whenever all such charges are paid, the vehicle shall be released to its owner. If a citation upon which removal and storage is authorized is released by the chief of police or his duly authorized representative or dismissed by the court because the citation was improperly issued, the chief of police or his duly authorized representative shall release the vehicle without payment of charges for removal and storage and shall refund any charges for removal and storage of such vehicle which shall have previously been paid.
