I called back Paul Tittl. He said he has another appointment that day as well.

However, he said that both he and Sen. LeMahieu fully support the reconstruction in lieu of the asphalt resurfacing option and are working on a letter that they would send to the Transportation Secretary and Gov. Evers requesting the reconstruction to be included in the next State budget.

He is hoping to have a draft of that letter by next Wed. and would send it to us prior to mailing it to the Secretary and Governor.

Paul asked about the cost. I told him probably on the order of \$5,000,000.

I know that I have told the PI Comm. a number around \$3,500,000, but if this becomes a DOT project the cost of the work is always significantly higher than a local bid. My numbers did not include complete sidewalk replacement which I would think we would want to include in the project. My cost estimate was extremely simple only looking at the length and width and using about \$90/SY. I did not look at how far we would go on each side street and many other details that keep increasing the cost.

Go look at what the DOT requires to maintain handicap access and general pedestrian access on Waldo Blvd.
