RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING STAFF TO APPLY TO THE WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES ("DNR") WISCONSIN ASSESSMENT MONIES ("WAM") PROGRAM FOR A PORTION OF THE RIVER POINT DISTRICT ("PROPERTY") BY THE CITY OF MANITOWOC ("CITY").

WHEREAS, the City considers the Property to meet the definition of "brownfield" due to the presence or potential presence of a hazardous substance, pollutant, or contaminant that hinders the expansion, redevelopment or reuse of the Property; and,

WHEREAS, the City recognizes that the environmental assessment of brownfields is an important part of protecting Wisconsin's resources; and

WHEREAS, a municipal resolution is required to apply for the WAM program; and

WHEREAS, the City will allow the DNR and its duly authorized representatives, agents or contractors access to inspect the Property and award records should the application be awarded.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by Mayor Justin M. Nickels and the Common Council of the City of Manitowoc that an application may be submitted to the DNR for community-managed funding under the WAM program, that the City will comply with all state and federal rules and requirements of the WAM program and that the Community Development Director is authorized to act on behalf of the City to submit an application to the DNR for community-managed funding under the WAM program, sign documents and take necessary action to comply with approved award activities.
