FINDINGS OF FACT CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND RECOMMENDATION

The Licensing Permits and Inspections Committee of the Common Council having conducted a hearing on Wednesday, July 30, 2014, in the above matter, pursuant to Wisconsin Statutues §125.12, regarding the application of Tiffany A. Grosshuesch ("the applicant") for renewal of her Operator's License; and

Bridget Brennan, Deputy Chief of Police, having appeared as the complainant and the applicant having appeared in response to the Notice of Intention Not to Renew License;

The Licensing Permits and Inspections Committee hereby make the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The applicant currently holds an Operator's License to dispense alcohol beverages.

- 3. The offenses listed above substantially relate to the licensed activity.
- 4. Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes §125.12(2)(b)3, the Committee finds the allegations of the Notice of Intention Not to Renew the License are true.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The arrest and conviction record of the applicant, while serious, is not sufficient in the judgment of the Committee to disqualify the applicant from renewal of her license. The Committee does feel, however, that any further offenses which substantially relate to the licensed activity would be sufficient cause for revocation or nonrenewal of the license.

RECOMMENDATION

The Licensing Permits and Inspections Committee hereby recommend that the license application of Tiffany A. Grosshuesch be granted.
