RESOLUTION

POLICE CHIEF NICK REIMER

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2015, the Police and Fire Commission of the City of Manitowoc appointed Assistant Police Chief Nick Reimer to the position of Police Chief for the City of Manitowoc upon the retirement of Police Chief Tony Dick on January 8, 2016; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc that the recommendation of the Police and Fire Commission to appoint Assistant Police Chief Nick Reimer as Police Chief for the City of Manitowoc is hereby approved effective January 9, 2016.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc that Police Chief Nick Reimer is placed at Grade S, Step 7 as a salaried position with an hourly rate of \$45.88 (\$95,430) in the City of Manitowoc Compensation Step Plan, effective January 9, 2016. On January 9, 2017, Police Chief Nick Reimer will move to Grade S, Step 8, of the City of Manitowoc Compensation Step Plan at an hourly rate of \$47.03 (\$97,822) based on a meeting expectations performance review rate, or above and thereafter he will follow the City of Manitowoc Compensation Step Plan including a step increase in July 2017.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Police Chief is authorized to fill any additional vacancies that result from filling the Police Chief position in accordance with the Compensation Plan, the Mayor's Executive Budget and the Labor Agreement with the Manitowoc Professional Police Association.
