TO AUTHORIZE APPLICATION FOR URBAN FORESTRY **GRANT OR URBAN FORESTRY CATASTROPHIC STORM GRANT**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Manitowoc will budget a sum sufficient to satisfactorily complete the project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Public Infrastructure of the City of Manitowoc is designated as the "Authorized Representative" for purposes of the grant application, and is hereby authorized and empowered by the City of Manitowoc to sign and submit the grant application and a grant agreement between the City and the DNR; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Public Infrastructure is further authorized to submit interim and/or final reports to the DNR to satisfy the grant agreement, submit grant reimbursement requests to the DNR, and sign and submit other required documentation as required by the DNR.
