Event description

The 2025 PDGA US Women's Disc Golf Championships will bring 350 of the best female disc golfers of all ages and from all over the world to Manitowoc for an entire week. The PDGA assists with the running of the event with help from many volunteers from all over Wisconsin. Players will be practicing Monday - Wednesday and competing Thurs - Sunday at Silver Creek Park, Lower Cato Falls and Rollin' Ridge DGC. We expect 500-1000 spectators following the Pro Women's divisions and many family and friends following the amateur divisions as well. All week long we will have community outreach events around Manitowoc and Two Rivers for the players and opportunities for the spectators to engage with the pros on and off the course.

The UW-Green Bay Manitowoc campus has offered us use of their parking lots and fields starting everyone off in one area. There will be a large putting green and warm-up field plus a few food trucks and portable rest rooms set up on the UW property. We have modified the hole numbers to have most groups starting on the hole closest to Eco-tech on N. 10th Street. No other major changes to the courses are required



beyond barricades at the park entrances and some bleachers. The soccer field will showcase the final par 5 hole 18 for Sunday's finals and food trucks and vendors will use the main parking lot while PDGA staff and video crews will share the fieldhouse. Our tournament staff will be at both the South end of the UW property and at the concession area at Silver Creek besides working with spectators and players on the course. Our goal is to guide the players/spectators from the time they arrive and encourage great viewing of the competition from many vantage points in the park.
