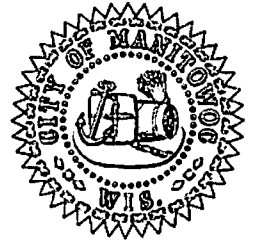

Re: Fire Engine Quotation

On December 9, 2020 bids were opened at the Board of Public Works for quotations received for the purchase of two new fire engines. Two quotes were received from separate vendors, both being from the State of Wisconsin. One of the quotes did not meet the specifications set forth by the MFRD fire engine committee in collaboration with fleet manager JJ Walvoord and the City mechanic's.

The quote that meets the specifications that were distributed, is \$38,137 over our allotted capital request for 2021. The funds are a split of \$532,399 from the MFRD vehicle account and \$697,601 in 2021 capital funding.

I would request authorization to sign the contract with the bid that met the specifications established by the committee and to work with finance and CAWG for the remaining funds needed. One opportunity for the additional funds might be the ability to hold off a future purchase from the MFRD vehicle account along our forecasted plan.
