Re: Refinishing the gymnasium floor at the Armory

The wood gymnasium floor in the Armory is in need of refinishing. The floor is 33 years old and has never been sanded down to the bare wood and re-sealed. Rather, City maintenance personnel and sometimes the roller rink operators have re-coated it on a yearly basis.

There are a few improvements that we'd like to take care of at this time such as adding pickle ball field markers and recessed volleyball pole sockets.

I have had a difficult time getting estimates but did receive one from the same company who installed the floor back in 1984. I am meeting with a second contractor on Monday, May 5<sup>th</sup>.

I should be able to have the second estimate by the time of your next meeting. I am asking that you consider taking up this topic at your next Public Infrastructure Committee meeting for discussion and possible action.
