Farmers' Market Ad-Hoc Committee

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Manitowoc to have the Farmers' Market be overseen by a Farmers' Market Ad-Hoc Committee, to serve as an advisory committee to the Common Council in order to promote the Farmers' Market and development of the City's downtown; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Committee shall serve as an advisory committee to the Common Council in order to oversee the operations and success of the Farmers' Market in Manitowoc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc that the Farmers' Market Ad-Hoc Committee be created, and shall have 12 voting members who shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Common Council for three year terms, with the exception of the Mayor, Alderperson from District 3 and the Downtown Farmers' Market Manager, whose terms shall be indefinite.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the membership of this Committee shall, when possible, include membership from a variety of backgrounds to create a diverse variety of interests and opinions, including at least one member from each of the following fields:

- Community Development Director
- Two Common Council Members, one being the Alderperson from District 3
- Four Downtown Business Owners
- Four Farmers' Market Vendors
- Mayor

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Committee shall have authority to make recommendations to the Common Council on the operations of the Farmers' Market.
