Dear Rec Department,

The Manitowoc Unit of Fish & Game is pleased to be a long-time partner with the City of Manitowoc and the Recreation Department. Our history has strong ties to Lincoln Park and our group was instrumental in the development of the Manitowoc Zoo. We have held our meetings at Lincoln Park for longer than most our members can remember, and that is saying a lot.

We want to thank the city and department for the grandfathering that has been granted to our unit for their meetings because of this history. We value having the new Cabin 1 for our regular meetings and to continue our history in Manitowoc. We have offered several times to help maintain the cabin and address other needs and issues in Lincoln Park, which we feel a strong heritage to as well. While we have had several indications of a desire to cooperate, we have not been able to generate any meaningful response or dialog. Meanwhile we feel some things in Cabin 1 should be addressed.

As we renew our relationship for 2022, we would like to again offer our commitment and assistance to Lincoln Park and the City of Manitowoc. The following are three specific things we would like you to consider:

- Have a Recreation Department leader as a guest speaker for one of the Manitowoc Unit meetings to discuss the current status and plans for Lincoln Park and Cabin #1. During this meeting a discussion will be held to determine specific things that our unit can do to support this process.
- 2. Form a Lincoln Park Advancement Committee that would have representatives of Fish & Game, the Rec Department and other interested citizens. The group would work to maximize the value and use of Lincoln Park for the people of the area. There had been past discussions of logging and forest management practices on the park that could create revenue for continued maintenance and development of this valuable public space. There are also other opportunities that could be discussed.
- 3. Identify how Manitowoc Fish & Game can partner and support the activities of the Manitowoc Zoo. Our unit has a history of partnership with this group that waned over the years. We welcome the opportunity to again support this. We just need to know what we can do to help.

The Manitowoc Unit currently represents almost 200 members and is part of Manitowoc County Fish & Game Protective Association. The county organization represents 25 sporting organizations and clubs and has over 2500 members county wide. The Manitowoc Unit is also the founder of the FORWARD Endowment, a charitable trust that has donated over \$130,000 for projects in Manitowoc County in hunting, fishing, conservation, and related education. This gives us additional tools and resources to complete projects that benefit the outdoor public good.

We ask for a formal response to this letter. Please let us know your thoughts and what we can do to further this strong historic relationship moving forward. We thank you in advance for your time and consideration.
