I generally agree with the area proposed for unlimited parking. My only recommendation will be to not allow any parking within about 25-50 feet of the driveway for the apartments and the proposed trail by the signed crosswalk. Especially by the crosswalk so that the pedestrians are visible for a long distance and not hidden behind parked cars. Legally or per State Statutes, it is 4 feet from a driveway and 15 feet from a crosswalk, but I would like to see these distances increase substantially for visibility.

I have forwarded your request to Amber at the PD for hopefully getting it on the September Public Safety Committee Agenda. That meeting will be on Monday, September 13th at 5:30 pm in the Council Chambers.
