## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a section of Rapids Road between Broadway and Custer Streets is being reconstructed and widened, and would require thirty (30) each, 250 Watt High Pressure Sodium street lights to meet ANSI RP-8 roadway lighting standards instead of the existing twenty two (22) each, 250 Watt High Pressure Sodium street lights, and

WHEREAS, City of Manitowoc Engineering Department deems it desirable to install LED lighting to illuminate the reconstructed section,

WHEREAS, the Manitowoc Public Utilities recommends installation of nineteen (19) each, 200-215 Watt LED, street lights to illuminate the reconstructed section to ANSI RP-8 roadway lighting standards, and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code 12.150(1)(a) provides that the installation of non-ornamental lighting systems for public street, parks or boulevards which is deemed necessary or desirable for the safety of pedestrian and vehicular traffic shall be ordered by the Common Council by the granting of petitions signed by owners of property abutting on the street or boulevard where lighting is desired or by resolution adopted by the Common Council, and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code 12.150(1)(b) provides that the installation costs for nonornamental lighting shall be borne by the Manitowoc Public Utilities, and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code 12.150(1)(c) provides that the operation, lamp renewal and maintenance expenses of the City's non-ornamental lighting shall be paid from the City's general fund on a month-to-month basis upon receipt of a bill from the Manitowoc Public Utilities. The rates for such service shall be those approved and on file with the Wisconsin Public Service Commission, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANITOWOC, that Manitowoc Public Utilities is ordered to replace twenty two (22) each, 250 Watt High Pressure Sodium, non-ornamental street lights with nineteen (19) each, non-ornamental, 200-215 Watt, LED street lights on Rapids Road between Broadway and Custer Streets.
