

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is expedient and necessary and in the best interest of the City of Manitowoc that certain infrastructure improvements be included in the 2023 Public Works Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Manitowoc, that the work listed below be included in the 2023 Street Improvement, Sanitary and Storm Sewer, and Miscellaneous Program, and that the Board of Public Works is herewith authorized and instructed to prepare plans and specifications and advertise for bids for work on these streets and miscellaneous projects.

CONCRETE PAVING

1. Reed Avenue – Approx. 300 ft. East of N. 2nd St. to North 8th Street
2. E. Albert Drive – Johnston Drive to approx. 800 feet East

ASPHALTIC CONCRETE RECONSTRUCTION AND RESURFACING

1. Division Street – South 9th to South 14th Street
2. Alley #12 Reconstruction – Bounded by N. 12th, N. 13th, New York Ave. & Wisconsin Ave.
3. Alley #18A & 18B Reconstruction – Bounded by N. 21st, N. 22nd, Emerson, & Rankin St.
4. Alley #22A & 22B Reconstruction – Bounded by Park Row, N. 21st, Waldo & RR Tracks
5. Evergreen Cemetery – Section B and Section S

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the abutting property will be assessed, per foot, per side, where applicable pursuant to the Wisconsin Statutes and the Municipal Code of the City of Manitowoc.
